## MEMORANDUM

Subject: Aquatic Habitat Restoration/Enhancement Work Plan

Attached is the proposed Aquatic Habitat Restoration/Enhancement Work Plan, which will be presented at the June Commission meeting for your approval. Although the estimated funding need for Aquatic Habitat Enhancement projects totals \$11,561,572, we anticipate that the maximum funding available will be less than \$10.5 million. Several projects are contingent on matching funds, multi-agency participation, permit acquisition, or appropriate environmental conditions.

Of the 109 potential projects listed on the attached work plans, lakes Panasoffkee, Trafford, Josephine and the Apalachicola River will be the major projects funded in fiscal year 2005-2006 (\$4.3 million).
