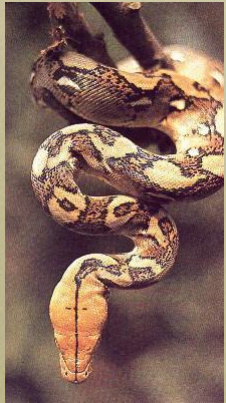

68A-6.003 – Facility and Structural Caging Requirements for Class I, II and III Wildlife.

(Neighbor notification)

In April, 2007, the Commission adopted this rule addressing facility requirements for Class I, II and III captive wildlife. We are proposing to amend this rule to include the notification of adjacent landowners by new applicants who want to possess Class I wildlife,

Draft Rules



68A-6.003:

- Would require new applicants for Class I wildlife to notify neighbors contiguous with the proposed facility location of their intent to possess such wildlife.
- Would require notification of neighbors of any change in license authorizations.
- Would require notification of neighbors, animal control officials and emergency responders of any escape of Class I wildlife from the facility.
