

**Establishment Order No: WMA 08-04**

**Belmore Wildlife Management Area**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) of the State of Florida, under Article IV, Section 9 of the Florida Constitution and the rules and regulations of the Commission, hereby establishes the Thomas Creek Wildlife Management Area in Clay County, Florida, with the following described area:

The legal description for the Belmore Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is contained in a letter from the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Forestry (DOF) dated December 12, 2007 requesting the land be established as a WMA. Legal descriptions for all properties within this request are located in Central Files of the FWC.

Request to establish land: 8,737 Acres **New for Feb. 2008**

All lands comprising approximately 8,737 acres and posted as a Wildlife Management Area.
