

**FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION  
GUEST PERMIT WORKSHEET  
2009 - 2010**

**REQUIREMENTS –**

- You must have a **valid Management Area Permit** or a license that includes a Management Area Permit, to apply for a Guest Permit (unless you are exempt from purchasing a Management Area Permit).
- For each non-transferable quota permit for the hunt types listed below, one **non-transferable** Guest Permit is allowed.
- Permit holder and guest **must share the same vehicle** and enter and exit the area together.
- Guest **may hunt only when the permit holder is present** on the area, and where zones apply, the two must hunt in the same zone.
- Permit holder and guest **must share a single bag limit**, and the quota hunt permit holder is responsible for making sure that the shared bag limit is not exceeded.
- The quota permit holder will need to provide the guest with his/her **Customer ID number and Hunt Number** OR the guest may provide the quota permit holder with the guest's Customer ID number and Date of Birth.
- Guests are limited to **one (1) Guest Permit per hunt number** and up to **five (5) Guest Permits per hunt type**.
- **Once issued, a guest permit cannot be changed.** It is suggested that you wait until just before your hunt to obtain a Guest Permit.
- Guest permits will be available beginning August 1, 2009 at license agent and tax collector offices only.
- All Guest Permit holders must **provide a picture ID** when using a Guest Permit.
- Lost Guest Permits can be **replaced at any license agent or tax collector office** for a \$2.00 fee.

**HOW TO APPLY –**

- To apply for a Guest Permit, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any **license agent or tax collector office**.
