REGULATIONS

In order to **apply** for a Dove Quota Hunt Permit, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any **license agent, tax collector's office, or you may apply online** at www.wildlifelicenses.com/fl, and choose "Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications."

- **Beginning 10:00 a.m. (Eastern Time), September 10, 2009 through 11:59 p.m. (Eastern Time), September 21, 2009 permits will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis.** Customers are limited to two permits and each permit must be for a different hunt date. To get **two permits**, you will need to complete **two worksheets** and apply two times.
- You **must have a valid Management Area Permit** (or a license that includes a Management Area Permit) in order to apply for a permit, unless you are exempt from license and permit requirements (See **Section ③** on the next page). Children age 15 that will turn 16 before or during the hunts should purchase a Management Area permit and apply as a non-exempt hunter.
- All hunters, (excluding the youth that accompany the permit holder) including disabled persons, military home on leave and senior citizens must apply for and receive a Quota Hunt Permit in order to participate in the Dove Quota Hunts.
- Each individual may receive no more than one permit per hunt date and no more than two permits for the season. A permit allows an adult, or an adult and a youth under the age of 16, to hunt together. The adult and the youth may each take a bag limit.
- Hunters that have been issued a permit must **check-in** at the check station on the date of the hunt between **11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.** (Eastern Time) or their permit will be voided as a **no-show**.
- If there are any **un-issued permits or no-shows** on the day of the hunt, they will be issued first come, first served at the check station beginning at 3:00 p.m. (Eastern Time).
- Permits are **transferable** from one hunter to another by simply giving the permit to another hunter. Permits issued to **exempt hunters** and marked "**EXEMPT**" may only be used by or transferred to another exempt hunter that would qualify for the same exemption. The exception is a "Senior Exempt" permit may also be transferred to a child under 16.
- **Hunt availability** may be checked at www.MyFWC.com Click on "Hunting" and under "Limited Entry Hunts" select "Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results."
- Permits that are lost or destroyed may only be replaced by the FWC Office of Licensing and Permitting. Only the license permittee may apply for replacements. You will need to **allow at least 10 days to receive the replacement permit**. Receipts and copies of the Internet pages may not be used as a Quota permit.
- **THE SELLING OR PURCHASING OF ANY QUOTA HUNT PERMIT IS PROHIBITED.**
