

FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION  
**LAKE WOODRUFF NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE**  
**DEER/HOG ARCHERY PERMIT WORKSHEET**  
2009 - 2010

**REQUIREMENTS –**

- You must be **16 years of age** or older and have **completed a certified hunter safety class** to apply for a Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge Deer/Hog Archery Permit.
- In addition to the Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge Deer/Hog Archery Permit, you must also obtain a free **Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge 2009-10 Hunt Permit**. This permit may be obtained by going to [www.fws.gov/lakewoodruff](http://www.fws.gov/lakewoodruff) and clicking on “Hunting Regulations.” By signing the permit, you acknowledge that you have read and understand the refuge regulations. Each hunter is required to keep a **signed hunt permit** in their possession while hunting.

**PERMIT INFORMATION –**

- Permits are **NOT transferable**.
- Each permit **allows the permit holder and one youth under the age 16 to hunt**. Youth under the age 16 do not need a permit, but must be accompanied by a permitted adult (age 18 or older).
- Hunters are limited to **one permit per person**.
- Lost or destroyed permits may be replaced at any license agent or tax collector office for a fee of \$2.

---

**HOW TO APPLY –**

- To apply for a permit, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any **tax collectors office; license agent or you may apply online** at [www.wildlifelicenses.com](http://www.wildlifelicenses.com), select “Florida” and choose “Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications.”
- If you are a Florida resident, but do not have a valid Florida driver license, you must apply at a tax collectors office or license agent and provide proof of Florida residency. Florida ID cards and “Valid in Florida only” driver licenses are not acceptable.

**PHASE I -----**

**WHEN TO APPLY –**

- **10:00 AM** (Eastern Time) **June 1, 2009** – 11:59 PM (Eastern Time) **June 30, 2009**

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW –**

- Permits will be issued by **random drawing**.
- You are limited to **one application and one permit** during this phase.
- There is no-cost for applying.
- If successful in the random drawing, you **must pay for and pick-up your permit** (\$16) at a **license agent or tax collector office** from **10:00 a.m.** (Eastern Time) on **July 21, 2009** thru 11:59 p.m. (Eastern Time) on **August 18, 2009**. Permits will not be mailed.
- If you are awarded a permit, be sure to take your **privilege code** and **hunt number** to the license agent or tax collector office. You can find this information and the drawing results at [MyFWC.com/hunting](http://MyFWC.com/hunting) under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results.” **Results** will be posted no earlier than July 2<sup>nd</sup> and no later than July 21<sup>st</sup>
- If you do not pay for your permit by **August 18, 2009**, your permit will be forfeited and made available in Phase II.

**PHASE II -----**

**WHEN TO APPLY –**

- **10:00 AM** (Eastern Time) **August 19, 2009** – until all permits are issued

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW –**

- Remaining permits will be issued **1<sup>st</sup> come, 1<sup>st</sup> served**.
- To check permit availability, go to [MyFWC.com/hunting](http://MyFWC.com/hunting), under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “**Check Permit Availability** and Drawing Results.”
- If you apply at a license agent or tax collector office and you are awarded a permit, you will receive your permit from the clerk.
- If you apply online during this phase and if you are successful, you must **pick up your permit at a license agent or tax collector** office anytime prior to hunting. You will need to know your **privilege code** and **hunt number** to pick up your permit. This information is on your **internet** confirmation page and at [MyFWC.com/hunting](http://MyFWC.com/hunting) under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results.”
