

FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION
MOBILITY-IMPAIRED QUOTA PERMIT WORKSHEET
2009 - 2010

REQUIREMENTS –

- You must possess a **Mobility Impaired Eligibility Certification Card** issued by the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) to apply for a Mobility Impaired quota permit.
- You must also have a **valid Management Area Permit** (or a license that includes a Management Area Permit) to apply for a quota permit, unless you qualify for one of the following exemptions:
 - Holder of a Resident No-Cost Hunting/Fishing Certificate for resident disabled sportsmen – you will need to provide your valid certificate number. Licenses issued prior to 07/01/1997 (Yellow Card) are **not valid** and you will be eliminated from the drawing if you use it to apply
 - Florida residents in the armed forces home on leave for 30 days or less - please contact FWC at (850) 488-3641 (M – F, 8 – 5 Eastern Time) prior to applying
 - Florida residents age 65 or older - must provide valid proof of age and Florida residency
 - Youth under 16 - must provide date of birth and social security number
- If you are an **exempt hunter** (qualify for one of the above exemptions), you must apply for and receive a quota permit to participate in these hunts.

PERMIT INFORMATION –

- Permits are **NOT transferable** (except Holton Creek permits) and you **must have a picture ID along** with your permit when using a non-transferable permit.
 - For each non-transferable quota permit, you are allowed to obtain **one guest permit**. See *Guest Permit Information*
 - Only Phase I applicants have the option to be included in the **antlerless deer permit** drawing in September.
 - You can replace **lost or destroyed** non-transferable quota permits and guest permits at any license agent or tax collector office.
 - Holton Creek permits are transferable but they may only be transferred to another Mobility Impaired hunter. These permits must be replaced by the FWC, Office of Licensing and Permitting, (850) 488-3641. Please allow 7-10 days for receipt of a replacement permit.
 - If you are unable to use your permit, you can return it for **re-issuance**. See *Returned Permits and Re-issuance Schedule*
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HOW TO APPLY –

- To apply for a quota permit, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any **license agent, tax collector office, or you may apply online** at www.wildlifelicense.com, select “Florida” and choose “Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications.”
- Children age 15 that will turn 16 before or during the hunts must purchase a Management Area Permit and apply as a non-exempt hunter.
- If you are a Florida resident, but do not have a valid Florida driver license, you must apply at a license agent or tax collector office and provide proof of Florida residency. Florida ID cards and “Valid in Florida only” driver licenses are not acceptable.
- If you are under the age of 16 and you do not have a driver license, you may apply online, but you must apply as a non-resident.

PHASE I -----

WHEN TO APPLY –

- **10:00 AM** (Eastern Time) **June 1, 2009** – 11:59 PM (Eastern Time) **June 30, 2009**

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW –

- Quota permits will be issued by **random drawing**.
- You are limited to **one application and one permit** during this phase.
- You, and up to four other hunters, can choose to apply as a group. To **apply as a group**, one person must first apply as group leader, indicate they are creating a group, and enter the hunt choices for the group. The group leader will be given a group number (prints on receipt) that must be given to the group members. Each group member must then submit an application and indicate the group number of the group they are joining. The group’s rank in the random drawing will be determined by the member with lowest number of preference points among the members.
- You can **check your preference points** at MyFWC.com/hunting, under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Preference Point Status.”
- To find the **drawing results** to see if you were successful in the random drawing, go to MyFWC.com/hunting, under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results”. **Results** will be posted no earlier than July 7th and no later than July 17th.
- If successful in the random drawing, **you will be mailed a permit**.
- If you are not successful in the random drawing, you will get **one preference point** for next year.

PHASE II -----

WHEN TO APPLY –

- **10:00 AM** (Eastern Time) **July 20, 2009** – 11:59 PM (Eastern Time) **August 3, 2009**

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW –

- Quota permits will be issued by **random drawing**.
- You can apply in Phase II even if you were already awarded a permit in Phase I or you did not apply in Phase I.
- You are limited to **one application and one permit** during this phase.
- To find the **drawing results** to see if you were successful in the random drawing, or to check permit availability, go to MyFWC.com/hunting, under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results.” **Results** will be posted no earlier than August 7th and no later than August 17th.
- If successful in the random drawing, **you will be mailed a permit**.
- **Group applications not accepted** in Phase II.

PHASE III -----

WHEN TO APPLY –

- **10:00 AM** (Eastern Time) **August 20, 2009** – until all permits are issued (see Reissuance Schedule for closed periods)

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW –

- Quota permits will be issued **1st come, 1st served**.
- You can apply in Phase III even if you have already been awarded a permit in Phase I or Phase II. You may get up to **five (5) permits** total (including permits awarded in Phase I or Phase II), but no more than **one permit per hunt number**.
- To **check permit availability**, go to MyFWC.com/hunting, under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results.”
- If you apply at a license agent or tax collector office and you are awarded a permit, you will receive your permit from the clerk.
- If you apply online during this phase and if you are successful, **you will be mailed a permit**.

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GUEST PERMIT INFORMATION –

- On all mobility-impaired hunts, one non-hunting unlicensed assistant may accompany a mobility-impaired hunter with a valid quota permit and participate in the hunt, provided the assistant may not take wildlife with a gun.
- For each non-transferable quota permit, you are allowed **one non-transferable guest permit** in addition to a non-hunting assistant.
- Permits issued for Holton Creek hunts are transferable. Guest permits are not available for Holton Creek hunts, however; you may still bring one non-hunting assistant.
- You and your guests **must share the same vehicle and you must enter and exit** the area together. **Parking is limited** on most WMAs and guest should not bring additional vehicles to the area.
- Your **guest permit holder may hunt only when you are present** on the area and, where zones apply, the two of you must hunt in the same zone.
- You and your guest permit holder **must share a single bag limit**, and you (the quota permit holder) are responsible for making sure that the shared bag limit is not exceeded.
- **To obtain a guest permit** - you will need to provide your Customer ID number and the hunt number to your guest in order for them to obtain a guest permit **or** you may obtain the guest permit if you have the guest's Customer ID number and Date of Birth.
- Only **one guest permit per hunt number** may be issued and the guest permit holder must have a **management area permit** (or a license that includes a management area permit) to apply (unless the guest is exempt from purchasing licenses and permits).
- Guest permits are **available beginning August 1, 2009 at license agents and tax collectors offices only.**
- Guest permits **may not be changed** once they are issued.

RETURNED PERMITS AND RE-ISSUANCE SCHEDULE –

- You may return a permit issued during any phase to: FWCC-Office of Licensing & Permitting, 2590 Executive Center Circle, Suite 200, Tallahassee, FL 32301
- If you would like to return a permit issued in Phase I and have your preference points re-instated (and an additional preference point awarded), it must be **postmarked prior to the first day of the hunt.**
- **Reissuance Schedule** for returned permits:

Closed periods are to allow hunters time to see the returned permits that will be available. Permit availability may be checked at MyFWC.com/hunting, under "Limited Entry Hunts" click "Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results."
