

FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION
QUAIL QUOTA PERMIT WORKSHEET
2009 - 2010

REQUIREMENTS –

- You must have a valid Management Area Permit (or a license that includes a Management Area Permit) to apply for a quota permit, unless you qualify for one of the following exemptions:
 - Holder of a Resident No-Cost Hunting/Fishing Certificate for resident disabled sportsmen – you will need to provide your valid certificate number. Licenses issued prior to 07/01/1997 (Yellow Card) are **not valid** and you will be eliminated from the drawing if you use it to apply
 - Florida residents in the armed forces home on leave for 30 days or less - please contact FWC at (850) 488-3641 (M – F, 8 – 5 Eastern Time) prior to applying
 - Florida residents age 65 or older - must provide valid proof of age and Florida residency
 - Youth under 16 - must provide date of birth and social security number
- If you are an **exempt hunter** (qualify for one of the above exemptions), you still must apply and receive a Quota Hunt Permit in order to participate in the Quail Quota hunt or be the guest of a permitted hunter.

PERMIT INFORMATION –

- Permits are **transferable** from one hunter to another by simply giving the permit to another hunter.
- Each permit allows up to 2 hunters
- You can replace **lost or destroyed** permits at license agent or tax collector offices for a fee of \$2.

HOW TO APPLY –

- To apply for a quota permit, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any license agent, tax collector office, or you may apply online at www.wildlifelicense.com, select “Florida” and choose “Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications.”
- Children age 15 that will turn 16 before or during the hunts should purchase a Management Area Permit and apply as a non-exempt hunter.
- If you are a Florida resident, but do not have a valid Florida driver license, you must apply at a license agent or tax collector office and provide proof of Florida residency. Florida ID cards and “Valid in Florida only” driver licenses are not acceptable.
- If you are under the age of 16 and you do not have a driver license, you may apply online, but you must apply as a non-resident.

PHASE I -----

WHEN TO APPLY –

- **10:00 AM** (Eastern Time) **November 20, 2009** thru **11:59 PM** (Eastern Time) **December 2, 2009**

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW –

- Quota permits will be issued by **random drawing**.
- You are limited to **one application and one permit** per person.
- To find drawing results to see if you were successful in the random drawing (or to check permit availability) go to MyFWC.com/hunting, under “Limited Entry Hunts” click “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results”. Results should be posted mid December.
- If successful in the random drawing, **you will be mailed a permit**.
