## 2009-2010 SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY FALL HUNT PERMIT

### WORKSHEET

#### REGULATIONS

In order to **apply** for Special Opportunity Fall Hunt Permits, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any **license agent, tax collector's office or you may apply online** at [www.wildlifelicense.com](http://www.wildlifelicense.com). Select "Florida" and then "Special Opportunity Applications." This worksheet may be photocopied and it may be downloaded at [www.MyFWC.com/hunting](http://www.MyFWC.com/hunting) in the "Special Opportunity Worksheet" section, of "Limited Entry Hunts."

- You may submit as many Special Opportunity Hunt worksheets as you like. **Apply** for as many different hunts, or as many times for the same hunt, as you like. You must submit a **\$5 per hunt NON-REFUNDABLE** fee for each worksheet submitted - **NO EXEMPTIONS**. A management area permit **is not required** to apply for or participate in a Special Opportunity Hunt.
- Special Opportunity Hunt Applications must be submitted between **10:00 a.m. (Eastern Time) May 1, 2009** and **11:59 p.m. (Eastern Time) May 31, 2009** in order to be included in the random drawing. Applicants will be limited to one permit per person, per hunt.
- If successful in the random drawing, you will receive a Special Opportunity invoice within three weeks of the application deadline. If you are successful in the random drawing and have a Lifetime Sportsman or Lifetime Hunting License that was issued before July 1, 1998, you are exempt from the permit fees and will receive a no-cost invoice that must be redeemed for a permit.
- Special Opportunity Fall Hunt Permits **may be paid** at any license agent, tax collectors office or online at [www.wildlifelicense.com/fl](http://www.wildlifelicense.com/fl). Select "Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications", press the "Start Now" button and then choose the "Pay for Awarded Permit" option. Permits must be paid for **by the deadline indicated on your invoice** or you will forfeit the permit. You cannot pay for your permit by mail. Unclaimed permits will be offered to the next applicants selected in the random drawing. Internet applicants will need to allow 7-10 days for delivery of the permit.
- Non-residents will be limited to 10% of the available permits for each hunt. There will be one permit per hunt available to non-residents if 10% of the permits is less than one permit.
- **Drawing results and Hunt availability** may be checked at [www.MyFwc.com/hunting](http://www.MyFwc.com/hunting) under "Limited Entry Hunts," then "Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results."
- Permits are **transferable** from one hunter to another by simply giving the permit to another hunter.
- Permits that are lost or destroyed may only be replaced by the FWC Office of Licensing and Permitting (850-488-3641). You will need to allow 10 days to receive the replacement permit. Receipts and copies of the Internet pages may not be used as a Special Opportunity Permit. **Keep your permit in a safe place.**
- Regulations and bag limits are provided in the **Management Area Regulations and Area Map brochures** produced for each area. These brochures may be obtained from the Commission, tax collectors, and license agents or from the FWC Web site at [www.MyFWC.com/hunting](http://www.MyFWC.com/hunting).
- Those individuals in possession of a Special Opportunity Hunt Permit for deer or hog still hunts are allowed to bring **one** non-hunting guest, provided that while hunting or scouting, the guest shall not occupy a vehicle separate from the permittee, shall not possess a gun, and shall be in the immediate vicinity (25 feet or less) of the permittee. Hunters under age 16 may have a non-hunting supervisor and hunters certified mobility-impaired may have a non-hunting assistant.
- Permits issued for the Blackwater Carr Unit Released Quail hunts allow four hunters per permit. Released quail hunters are required to bring their own birds for release. Permits issued for hog dog hunts allow two hunters, one gun and up to three dogs per permit.

## Please Read the Regulations Before Completing This Worksheet

- **Section ①** PRINT your Customer ID number (located above your name on a current license), your Driver's License Number or your Social Security Number and your Date of Birth. In order for a resident to apply online, you must have a valid Florida Drivers License (Florida ID Card or Florida Only Drivers License not acceptable). Florida residents who do not have a Florida Drivers License must apply at a license agent or tax collector's office and provide proof of Florida residency. Florida youth under the age of 16, who do not have a Florida Drivers License, may apply online as a Non-Resident using their Social Security number.

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) collects social security numbers (SSN) for the issuance of recreational and professional fishing or hunting licenses or permits to an individual in accordance with s. 372.561 F.S. and 42 USC 666 for the purposes of administration of the Title IV-D program for child support enforcement, use by the commission, and as otherwise provided by law.

- **Section ②** PRINT your name and mailing address. Be sure this address is the mailing address for the applicant. **Do not use an address that does not belong to the applicant – the post office is returning these permits in most cases.**

- **Section ③** In the space marked "**Hunt Choice**," indicate which hunt you would like to apply for. Use the four digit hunt number that appears to the left of the hunt you choose. Indicate the number of times you are applying for that hunt area and then calculate the Amount Due. **You may only apply for one hunt choice per transaction.**

- Present this worksheet to any license agent, tax collector's office (be sure to ask the clerk to return your worksheet to you) or you may apply on line at [www.wildlifelicense.com](http://www.wildlifelicense.com), select "Florida" and choose "Special Opportunity Hunt Applications." Special Opportunity Fall Hunt Permits **may be paid** at any license agent, tax collectors office or online at [www.wildlifelicense.com/fl](http://www.wildlifelicense.com/fl). Select "Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications", press the "Start Now" button and then choose the "Pay for Awarded Permit" option.
