REGULATIONS

In order to **apply** for St Marks National Wildlife Refuge Mobility-Impaired Gun Hunt Permit, you will need to complete this worksheet and present it to any **license agent, tax collector’s office or you may apply online** at www.wildlifelicense.com/fl and choose “Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications.

- These permits are **not transferable**.
- Applicants will be limited to **one application and one permit per person**.
- Each applicant must submit a **\$5 NON-REFUNDABLE** application fee. A Wildlife Management Area permit is not required to apply for a St. Marks General Mobility-Impaired Permit.
- Applications may be submitted beginning at **10:00 a.m. (Eastern Time) June 15, 2009** through **11:59 p.m. (Eastern Time) July 30, 2009** in order to be included in the random drawing. Applications may be submitted at any license agent, tax collector’s office or on-line at www.wildlifelicense.com/fl and choose “Limited Entry/Quota Permits and Applications.
- If successful in the random drawing, you must pick up and pay for your St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge Mobility-Impaired Hunt Permit at a license agent or tax collector office. You cannot pay for your permit by mail or online.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- These hunts are **not** intended for all hunters who have a Total and Permanent Disabled Hunting and Fishing Certificate – only the ones that have been certified by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission as Mobility-Impaired.
- **Mobility-Impaired** is defined as: (a) Paraplegic (b) Hemiplegic (c) Quadriplegic (d) Permanently dependant upon a wheelchair for ambulation (e) Permanently required to use assisting aids to walk (f) Permanently required to use braces or prosthesis on both legs (g) Complete single-leg amputation
- Hunters who meet the above criteria may obtain a Mobility-Impaired Eligibility Certification application from any office of the FWC or thru the internet at www.MyFWC.com/ADA.
- Mobility-Impaired hunters **are allowed** to bring one **helper**. Helper permits will be issued at the hunt briefing if the helper hunts. The helper and Mobility-Impaired permit holder must share a bag limit.

- **Drawing results and Hunt availability** may be checked at www.MyFwc.com/hunting under “Limited Entry Hunts” then “Check Permit Availability and Drawing Results.”
- **Lost or destroyed** St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge permits can be replaced at license agents or tax collector offices for a fee of \$2.
- Regulations and bag limits are provided by the St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) – Refuge Specific Regulations Brochures. These brochures will be mailed to successful applicants and may be obtained from the St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge office or online at www.MyFWC.com/hunting under “Wildlife Management Areas – Public Hunting Lands.”
