The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) collects Social Security Number (SSN) for the issuance of recreational and professional fishing or hunting licenses or permits to an individual in accordance with s. 379.352 F.S. and 42 USC 666 for the purposes of administration of the Title IV-D program for child support enforcement, use by the commission, and as otherwise provided by law.

Chapter 837.06, Florida Statutes provides that whoever knowingly makes a false statement in writing with the intent to mislead a public servant in the performance of his or her official duty shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or 775.083, Florida Statutes. When this application is received by a state agency, the information contained therein becomes public record subject to inspection under provisions of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes.

Upon receipt of the \$10.00 replacement fee, the original license will be deactivated and will be invalid, therefore, if subsequently recovered, please return to the address stated above.
