17	48	Stormwater Treatment Area 1 West	<p><b>Description:</b> Area is now open to the public, sunrise to sunset Friday through Monday, foot and bicycle traffic only. During hunting season (September to November 15) the area is closed to the public one day per weekend. South Florida Water Management District recreation line: (866) 433-6312, or FL 1-800-432-2045. New boardwalks, restrooms, viewing platform added.</p> <p><b>Directions:</b> From West Palm Beach: Travel about 21 miles west on S.R. 80/U.S. 441 to the intersection of CR 880 and SR 80. Look for a flashing yellow light and a sign that says Welcome to Western Palm Beach County. Turn south on CR 880 and cross a green metal bridge; continue south.
