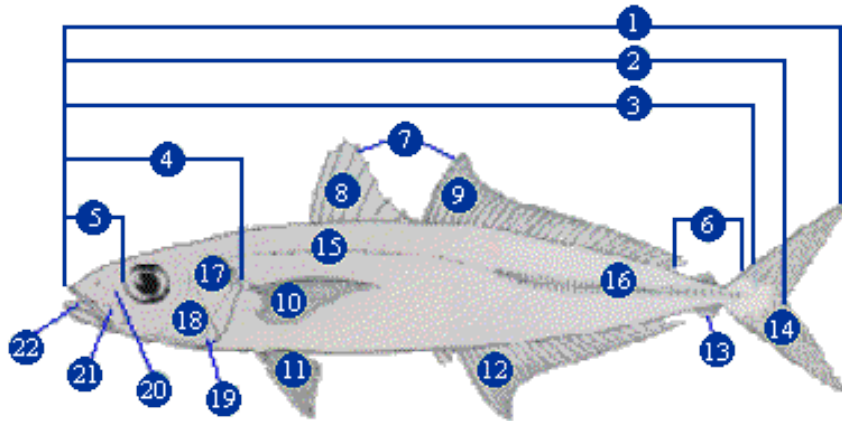




# Fish Identification Diagram



**1.** Total Length

**2.** Fork Length

**3.** Standard Length

**4.** Head Length

**5.** Snout Length

**6.** Caudal peduncle (where the body  
attaches to the tail)

**7.** Fin rays, spinous (unsegmented)  
and soft (segmented)

**8.** First (spinous) dorsal fin

**9.** Second (soft) dorsal fin

**10.** Pectoral fin

**11.** Pelvic (ventral) fin

**12.** Anal fin

**13.** Finlet

**14.** Caudal (tail) fin

**15.** Lateral line

**16.** Scutes (bone-like projections)

**17.** Opercle (gill cover)

**18.** Preopercle (cheek)

**19.** Interopercle

**20.** Adipose eyelid

**21.** Supramaxilla (rear portion of  
upper jaw bone)

**22.** Premaxilla (forward portion of  
upper jaw bone)
