

# **Things to bring**

Lodging is dormitory style; participants furnish their own bed linens and personal items. If you would like to, you may also bring your own equipment to use at the workshop such as a camera, binoculars, firearm, rod and reel, life vest, etc., but this is not a requirement. **Remember, firearms must remain in locked vehicles until checked by an instructor.** Also, if you plan on attending arts and crafts during the evening activities, you may want to bring a hat, plain white handkerchief or a t-shirt (or anything else you can think of) to decorate with some fabric paints. The following is a list of suggested items to bring with you to the workshop:

- Air Mattress for Twin bed (optional)
- Bath Soap & Shampoo
- Bathing Suit\*
- Bed Linens (single bed)
- Canteen or Water Bottle (for classes that go on hikes)
- Cash/Checks for silent auction, BOW t-shirts, pins, etc.
- Drinking Water
- Earplugs (snoring)
- Extra Shoes (wet pair)
- Flashlight and Sunscreen
- Jacket & Cap or Hat
- Lawn Chair
- Light Blanket or Sleeping Bag
- Long pants, shorts, t-shirts
- Mattress Pad (for bed/optional)
- Mosquito Repellent
- Permanon (tick repellent)
- Pillow
- Rain Gear
- Reading Glasses
- Shower shoes
- Sturdy Closed in Shoes or Boots
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Towel and Wash Cloth

\* Bring a bathing suit or clothes you can get wet if you are scheduled to attend the canoeing/kayaking class.

## **REMINDERS**

- If you took any **bass, pan or fly fishing classes**, you need a **Florida Fishing License**.
- Please turn off (or operate in silent mode) cell phones and beepers during workshop. If you must take/make a call, please step away from the class.
- If you took boating basics or canoeing/kayaking, or any class that requires a hike in the woods, it is recommended you bring a pair of shoes and clothes that can get wet/muddy. Students taking the Black Powder Firearms class should wear old clothes; they might get stained. Students taking Outdoor Photography Basics bring your camera instruction manual.
- No alcohol. No smoking in any of the buildings.
- All classes will go on regardless of the weather, so be sure to bring your rain gear, just in case.
